Maths	<b>Measures (Mass)</b> Pick 10 items from your kitchen cupboards and look for the mass of them (the weight in grams or kilograms)  *Can you order them from smallest to largest?  *Can you convert their measurement between g and kg? e.g. 425g = 0.425kg 550g = 0.55kg 700g = 0.7 kg  *Can you add 2 or 3 of them together and work out their weight in grams and kilograms?  Repeat with another set of different items	<b>Measures (Capacity)</b> Pick 10 items from your kitchen or bathroom cupboards and look for the capacity of them (how much liquid they contain in litres or millilitres)  *Can you order them from most to least capacity?  *Can you convert their measurement between ml and l? e.g. 378ml = 0.378l 150ml = 0.15l 600ml = 0.6l  *Can you add 2 or 3 of them together and work out their capacity in litres and millilitres?  Repeat with another set of different items	<b>Measures (Length – cm / m)</b> Pick 10 items from around your house and measure their length in cm  *Can you convert their measurement between cm and m? e.g. 16cm = 0.16m 20cm = 0.2m 135cm = 1.35m  *Can you add 2 or 3 of them together and work out their length in cm and m?  Repeat with another set of different items	<b>Measures (Length – mm / cm)</b> Pick 10 items from around your house and measure their length in both cm and mm  *Can you convert their measurement between mm and cm? e.g. 4cm = 40mm 15cm = 150mm 27.8cm = 278mm  *Can you add 2 or 3 of them together and work out their length in cm and mm?  Repeat with another set of different items	<b>Problem Solving: Measures (Mass)</b>  Find recipes for 2 food items that you would like to cook (or eat!) ( <i>You need ones with recipes in grams!</i> )  Can you convert the recipes so that you could make enough for everyone in Year 4? ( <i>19 children / you can include Miss Merritt &amp; Mrs Biggins also if you want to!</i> )
