<p>Maths Finding a half (2) Using even numbers only children should find half of an amount. The children can draw / use toys to show an amount - can they then see the best way to split the objects/pictures in half - they can number each picture 1 or 2, they could split the pictures/objects down the middle. How can they check their answer is correct? Which way was their favourite way to half an amount?</p>	<p>Maths Find a quarter (1) Show children images of shapes that have been quartered - explain that quarters are 4 equal parts. Using shapes that have been 'cut' into quarters can children shade one quarter of a shape. EXT: Can children show a quarter in more than one way using a square? A rectangle? Etc. I have attached a sheet which will help to support the concepts of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$. Please feel free to use</p>	<p>Maths Finding quarter (2) Finding quarter of an amount using pictures/ objects. Using pictures or concrete objects can children find a quarter of the amount by sharing equally into four groups. There are some ideas to support this on Twinkl or on White Rose Week 2 Lesson 3.</p>	<p>Maths Finding a quarter (3) Continuing on from yesterday can children find a quarter of an amount - they may still need to use objects / pictures to support their learning. Explain to children one way to think about quarters is halving then halving again - e.g. children know that half of 8 and half of 4 so they can find $\frac{1}{4}$ of 8 by using this knowledge: $\frac{1}{2}$ of 8 is 4, $\frac{1}{4}$ of 8 is 2</p>	BANK HOLIDAY
